IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. A peremptory writ of mandamus shall issue from the court commanding respondents to cease and desist from further operation of the Harvey O. Banks Pumping Plant Operation within sixty days from the date of entry of judgment until and unless they have obtained authorization in compliance with the California Endangered Species Act from the Department of Fish & Game with regard to their incidental take of Chinook Salmon Winter-run, Chinook Salmon Spring-run, and Delta Smelt.
- Petitioner shall recover costs in this proceeding, in an amount to be determined by petitioner's filing of a memorandum of costs within 15 days after the date of mailing of the notice of entry of this judgment.
